**Arizona Golf Industry Increasing Barter Activity in Lean Times**  
*Four New Golf Courses Join Arizona Trade Exchange, Dozens Others Express Interest*

At the same time, those golfers are spending cash for food and beverage on the course and in the clubhouse and equipment in the pro shop.”

The Arizona golf industry, which relies heavily on tourism, has suffered due to the number of visitors in the Valley being lower than it has been in years past. Even high-end golf courses have seen their revenues drop. Golf courses are a great fit for trade exchanges because it costs then virtually nothing to allow golfers to play on trade.
